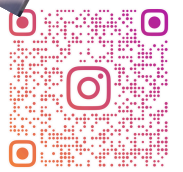
## ST PETERS FAIR

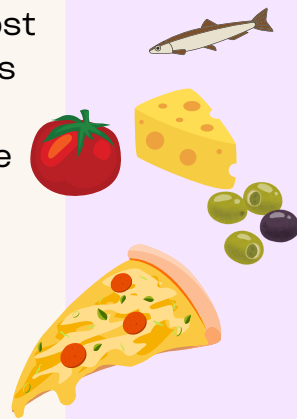
